- If a member of the volunteer/JR.worker cohort or someone in their household has covid-19 symptoms
 - Individuals will not participate in WLL activities for 10 days from the first day of symptoms(must be symptom free for 72 hours without medication etc..)
- If a member of the volunteer/JR. worker worker cohort is positive for COVID-19
 - Individuals will not participate in WLL activities for 14 days, all members of the cohort will be notified via email and activities for that cohort will be suspended for 14 days.(all cohort members and their families should be symptom free for 72 hours before returning)
- If a member of the volunteer/JR. worker cohort lives with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 then they will quarantine for 14 days .(player and their family must be symptom free for 72 hours before returning)
- If a member of the volunteer/JR. worker cohort is quarantined at home due to potential coronavirus exposure at school
 - Individuals will not participate in WLL activities until they have been given the ok to return to school even if they have received a negative test result.
- If a member of the volunteer/JR. worker cohort has been exposed to someone suspected or confirmed to have COVID-19
 - Individuals will not participate in WLL activities for 10 days or 7 days with negative test from the last known date of contact..(must be symptom free for 72 hours before returning)
- Appropriate notifications will be made by email using one of the following letters.

- All possible contact and positive contact information will be kept in a confidential binder by the WLL snack bar coordinator.
